LAUNCH YOUR MS CAREER

FELLOWSHIP AND JUNIOR FACULTY AWARDS

SYLVIA LAWRY PHYSICIAN FELLOWSHIP

- Mentored post-residency training in the design and conduct of MS clinical trials for board eligible/certified neurologists licensed in the U.S.
- Formal coursework in clinical research included in training
- 1 to 3-year award
- Open to those PGY-3 or PGY-4
- \$65,000/year for salary, fringe benefits, and/or tuition

MS CLINICAL CARE PHYSICIAN FELLOWSHIP

- Mentored post-residency program to train board eligible/certified neurologists or physiatrists in MS diagnosis and comprehensive clinical care
- Fellowship to include exposure to multidisciplinary team activities, lectures, and professional meetings to acquire skills necessary to provide highest quality care for individuals with MS
- 1-year award
- \$75,000/year for salary, fringe benefits

NATIONAL MS SOCIETY – AMERICAN BRAIN FOUNDATION MS CLINICIAN SCIENTIST DEVELOPMENT AWARD

- Mentored training for post-residency physicians committed to a career in academic MS research
- Open to PGY-4 and 5 residents/fellows licensed in the U.S.
- 3-year award
- +/- \$75,000/year for salary plus institutional allowance

POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

- Mentored training for MD or PhD postdoctoral fellows in basic or translational MS-related research projects
- Open to individuals with 0-36 months of postdoctoral training
- 1 to 3-year award
- Salary plus institutional allowance

CAREER TRANSITION FELLOWSHIP

- Provides 2 years of mentored advanced postdoctoral training and 3 years of faculty support for MDs or PhDs pursuing research projects in MS
- Open to individuals with 2-5 years of previous postdoctoral training
- Mid-May preliminary application deadline
- Salary and \$25,000/year research allowance for postdoctoral phase and \$125,000/year in direct costs for faculty phase

HARRY WEAVER SCHOLAR AWARD

- Highly competitive, prestigious non-mentored junior faculty award
- Open to independent MS researchers at U.S. institutions with up to 7 years in a faculty position
- Salary and limited research support for 5 years

BIOSTATISTICS /INFORMATICS JUNIOR FACULTY AWARD

- Open to junior academic faculty within 5 years of PhD or equivalent in biostatistics, bioinformatics, data science or related
- Collaborate with MS research group to develop/enhance statistical methods relevant to MS research
- Up to 3 years of partial salary or support to protect time, plus data expenses

For all fellowships, the applicant must make arrangements with a mentor and sponsoring institution prior to the application. APPLICATION DEADLINE: SUMMER (SEE WEBSITE FOR DETAILS) | START DATE FOR FUNDING: JULY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR
