When it comes to rare and complex conditions, we are a leading national and international pediatric referral center, known globally for our niche clinical expertise, research capabilities and top pediatric training program.

NEARLY \$130 MILLION IN NIH GRANT FUNDING LAST YEAR

We are third in National Institute of Health (NIH) grantfunding among all pediatric programs.

MORE THAN 100 TRAINING PROGRAMS

We train about **200 residents in six pediatric programs per year and offer a total of 117 residency, fellowship and post-doctoral education programs.** This makes Cincinnati Children's one of the largest sponsors of pediatric graduate medical education in the country. Our Department of Pediatrics, affiliated with the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, was named one of the top three in the nation by *U.S. News & World Report* in 2016.

FOCUS ON "NICHE AND NOVEL" PROGRAMS

Over the last 18 years, we have established national and international referral centers for "niche and novel" medical and surgical programs. This commitment has resulted in significant volumes in highly specialized areas. For example, we average **117 pediatric airway reconstructions each year**—that's about three times the total number of procedures performed at any other medical center.

DEDICATED TO COLLABORATION, TRANSPARENCY AND IMPROVING OUTCOMES

We've achieved breakthrough results in the reduction of major causes of harm for children receiving hospitalized care at Cincinnati Children's. Our success led to a collaborative partnership that has grown to a network of 80+ children's hospitals nationwide working together to prevent serious harm. Together, this national effort has led to an estimated savings of more than \$79 million and protected thousands of children from serious harm.
