GREAT LAKES

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$1,193,220** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Great Lakes Chapter Parkinson's Disease (PD) Community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **2,270** health professionals
- Offered help through **4,560** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **64,700** free publications in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Cleveland Clinic Ohio)

Treated **2,120** people at our Centers of Excellence

20 enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



RESEARCH

- **10** researchers received grants totaling **\$987,800**
- **40** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective

EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT



- **4,080** **Aware in Care** kits prepared people for the hospital
- **2,380** people participated in educational programs
- **590** people received free services through **6** community grants totaling **\$85,400**
- **5,750** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,595,180** through Moving Day
